



## **United Learning Summer Camp COVID-19 Safety and Testing Plan**

- *Only* students, staff and volunteers are encouraged to enter the building on a daily basis. We welcome parents to come in on the first day to see our space and on as-requested basis.
- All students, volunteers, and staff are required to wear a mask at all times.
- All students, staff and volunteers arriving will have their temperature taken and be screened for symptoms (**Fever or chills, Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Fatigue, Muscle or body aches, Headache, Recent loss of taste or smell, Sore throat, Congestion, Nausea or vomiting, Diarrhea**) upon arrival. This will all be logged in our daily sign-in/temp log binder.
- If a student answers yes to any of these symptoms or has a fever, parents will be asked to promptly return to pick them up from the program. Students will also be required to get tested within 36 hours and receive negative results for COVID-19 before returning to the program. A list of free test sites will be provided upon request.
- Social distancing of 3 feet must be observed at all times. When staff and students cannot maintain social distancing, masks will be observed.
- Students will be assigned a computer and must use that same computer at every session.
- Hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes will be available at all times. All student stations will be sanitized in between student use.
- Regular hand-washing will be strongly encouraged.
- If a student, staff member, or volunteer in the program tests positive for COVID-19 during the duration of the program, all parents, staff, and volunteers will be notified immediately, and the program will be closed for two weeks to observe quarantining for all students, staff, and volunteers.
- Students and parents are required to sign an agreement regarding expectations for

behavior during the program, including maintaining distance and wearing masks. The safety and health of our students, staff and volunteers is our utmost concern. If a student shows a repeated pattern of not following the behavioral expectations, they may be suspended or dismissed from the program.

- UCHM will provide proper PPE daily, including masks, gloves, hand sanitizer, and disinfectant cleaning supplies.
- All staff and volunteers will be trained on the United Learning Safety and Testing Plan.
